Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information request submitted via email to Criminal Justice Inspection Northern Ireland (CJI) received on 27 August 2019 in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and subsequent email response to points of clarification sought from you and received by CII in respect of your request on 28 August 2019.

In respect of your request, our understanding of the information you requested following your response to the points of clarification sough is as follows:

- the total expenditure on consultants broken down over each of the last three years, listing how much was paid to each company for each individual piece of work;
- that the consultants which you have requested the information in relation to are external consultants: and
- the three years you have clarified to mean the last three financial years (i.e. 2016-17 to 2018-19).

In addition you have requested that:

CJI provide a short comment as to what the purpose/objective was of each service.

In response to your request I can confirm that CJI has not incurred any expenditure in relation to external consultants during the last three financial years (2016-17 to 2018-19) and therefore has no further information to provide in respect of your request.
