Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 received by email to Criminal Justice Inspection Northern Ireland (CJI) on 19 June 2024.

Our understanding of the information you have requested is as follows:

- please provide the number, nature, and costs of the investigations you have undertaken over the last five years.

We have taken your reference to the time frame *over the last five years* to mean the last five financial years, that is 2019-20 to 2023-24.

In response to your request, I can advise that as CJI does not carry out investigations we therefore do not hold the information you have requested, however copies of all our [Inspections](#) and [Follow-Up Reviews](#) of criminal justice organisations and other organisations and bodies with a regulatory or prosecutorial role which interface with the criminal justice system that fall within our statutory remit¹ completed by CJI during last five financial years are published on our website - www.cjini.org and can be accessed using the links above in this response.

As we do not record the overall cost of individual Inspections or Follow-Up Reviews, we are unable to provide this information to you.
