Thank you for your Freedom of Information request submitted via email to Criminal Justice Inspection Northern Ireland on 22 April 2009 in accordance with Section 8 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Our understanding of the information requested is as follows:

- whether any employees receive private healthcare benefits, including private healthcare/medical insurance, paid for by the agency as part of their contract of employment
- if we have employees receiving private healthcare benefits paid for by the agency as part of their contract of employment, to supply full details of the nature of the benefit, the total number of employees to whom this applies and the job titles to whom this applies.

In answer to your request for information I can inform you that no employees with Criminal Justice Inspection Northern Ireland receive private healthcare benefits including health/medical insurance, paid for by the organisation as part of their contract of employment.

I hope this response satisfies your request.
